#### National Christmas Tree Lighting Ceremony

The tradition of the National Christmas Tree on the Ellipse began with President Calvin Coolidge over 90 years ago. Today, the tree lighting remains a beloved holiday in DC. The tree is decorated with handmade ornaments from the 56 US states and territories.

On December 5th, you can watch the 2021 National Christmas Tree lighting Ceremony on CBS and online.

#### **Capitol Christmas Tree Lighting Ceremony**

The Capitol Christmas Tree is erected every winter on the West Front Lawn of the United Sates Capitol. The tradition has been underway since 1919. It is lit during a ceremony in early December with plenty of live entertainment. Check online for updates about the 2021 ceremony.





#### Holiday Boat Parade at the Wharf
