


What is TLA Housing?



- TLA housing: USG stipend that covers the cost of your lodging
- Program funding type and country agreements determine whether or not you receive TLA housing
- You have a choice for housing opt-in or opt-out
- Goal: to get you and your families get settled quickly and happily, and to get you ready for your school year
- My advice to you
 - Please trust our advice we have your best interests at heart and we have accommodated over 600 Fellows and family members in recent years
 - Always feel free to ask for assistance—we are your advocate



Opt-In: What does it include?



- Corporate-style apartments in Crystal City
- Fully furnished
- All utilities included (water, heating, electricity, cable and internet)
- No security deposit (usually equal to one month's rent)
- One parking space (proof of vehicle registration in your name required)
- Bi-weekly maid service
- Monthly rent payments directly to Suite Solutions off the fund cite on your ITO
- Airport greeting for you and accompanying dependents (on same flight)

Apartment Buildings



- Crystal City is a highly desirable area with excellent schools
- All apartment complexes have 24-hour security, business centers, exercise facilities
- All within walking distance of a metro stop and grocery store, and other opt-in NDU students
- Parking is limited and towing is enforced!
 - 1 car per unit, provide registration info Suite Solutions
- Corporate housing ≠ hotel
- Doors automatically lock in Crystal House! Always take your key.

What does fully furnished mean?



- Includes all furniture, bedding and housewares
- Housewares: pots/pans/dishes/glasses, etc
- Standard furniture package for ALL apartments
 - Inventory standard for U.S. apartments
 - Number of items is based on apartment size
 - One bedrooms have fewer items than three bedrooms
 - Additional items can be purchased on your own or rented from Suite Solutions
 - Costco, Amazon, Walmart: Balcony furniture, desks for children, additional chairs, etc

Maid Service





- Biweekly maid service included (every other week)
- Starts next week
- Scheduled during typical class time to accommodate your class schedule (0900-1500)
- Many maids do not speak much English
- Maid service will change sheets/towels, and do light vacuuming and cleaning. Will not clean windows or do heavy moving
- Maids will not move items to clean will clean around everything

Utilities





- There are financial limits placed on your utilities of gas and/or electric. If you
 exceed these limits you are personally required to pay the excess this is not
 reimbursable.
- Keep a consistent temperature in your apartment, this uses less energy.
- Do not turn the thermostat up or down all the time and do not leave windows/doors open

Opt-In: What does it not include?



- Pay-per-view movies
- Cannot change TV or phone company
 - Can pay to add additional streaming service (Netflix, Hulu, etc)
- No international calling
- Locked out of apartment? Community charges \$100 per lockout
- Damages
- Renter's insurance (covers your personal belongings in apartment)
- Bedbugs (2nd treatment & beyond)
- Additional charges will be your responsibility

Damages



- You are responsible for any damages in your apartment, beyond normal wear and tear
 - Includes scratches, coloring on walls, nail polish spills, desk carving, serious carpet stains, stickers/tape directly on paint
- Bed bugs if apartment has to be treated more than once, you are responsible
 - All apartments have been inspected and declared free of bedbugs prior to your move in.
 - If you have any suspicions, please contact Suite Solutions ASAP.
- Inspections will be done as needed and in May
- Renter's insurance is highly recommended

Tips for Apartment Living



- Be courteous of your neighbors
- Supervise children in common areas
- Children <16 CANNOT get a FOB (community rules)
- Limit food left outside of refrigerator
- Pests move easily throughout units
- Fire alarms a favorite of children
 - Evacuate the entire building
- Purple binder on coffee table has community rules, hours, etc.

Implications of COVID-19
