On January 28th, NDU President Vice Admiral Roegge presided over the induction of General Andika Perkasa into the university's International Hall of Fame in a ceremony held at Ft. McNair. General Perkasa, an eminent graduate of NWC class of 2004, became the 71st member of the Hall of Fame, following his appointment as Chief of Staff of the Indonesian Army in 2018.

The award commemorates the great extent and distinction of the General's years of military service, his dedication to expanding the joint national security interests of the United States and Indonesia. We expect great strides toward peace and collaboration yet to come!

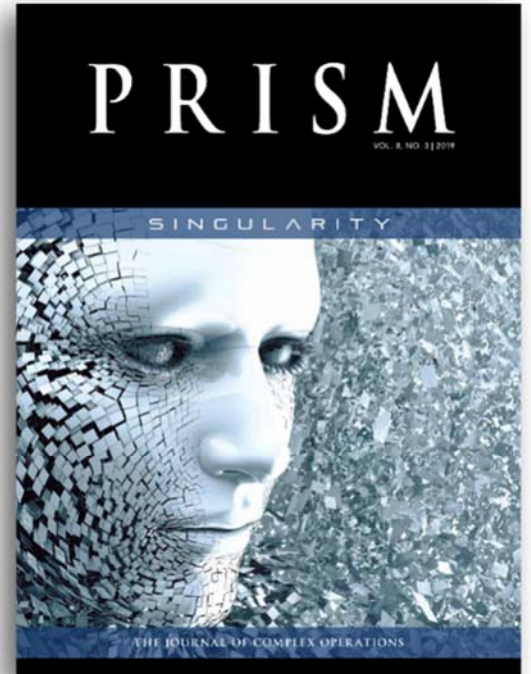
